MARIE CURIE CANCER CARE

Various Hospice sites throughout UK

Marie Curie is a registered charity providing care and support for people living with any terminal illness and dates back to 1948. They have the largest number of hospice beds outside the NHS operating from 10 sites. They also operate from a nationwide network of retail units.



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Number of sites: 10 throughout UK | Instruction delivery: 3 weeks

Dunlop Heywood were appointed to inspect and prepare reinstatement cost assessments on 10 hospices at various locations. The timeframe from instruction to delivery of report was tight requiring immediate mobilisation by the Team.
